THE need for a light, fast-shooting, accurate firearm for law-enforcement officers has been vividly demonstrated in the concerted drive now being waged against criminals. Authorities soon discovered the futility of trying to apprehend desperate racketeers and kidnapers with ordinary sidearms and rifles. Seldom do criminal gangs allow officers to shoot at anything except a fast-fleeing target. Furthermore, criminals themselves are certain to possess the most efficient equipment obtainable.

● The Thompson Sub-machine Gun has proved to be the ideal weapon to overcome the odds enjoyed by organized crime. Extremely portable, weighing little more than an ordinary rifle, and can be shot from

either shoulder or hip. Standard 45 caliber automatic pistol ammunition is fired from either 20-shot clip or 50-shot drum magazines. This weapon is not to be confused with heavy, high-powered military machine guns. The Thompson Gun can be operated by anyone familiar with a pistol or rifle. Since comparatively low velocity pistol ammunition is used, the Thompson Gun does not endanger lives of those far from the scene of combat.

● The psychological effect of the presence of a Thompson Sub-machine Gun in the arsenal of a police department, sheriff's office or penal institution is in itself a tremendous deterrent to crime and violence. The boldest, most heavily armed gunmen or convicts will retreat before the withering barrage that this gun releases. Mob violence is not likely to be attempted in a community or institution where officials are equipped with Thompson guns.

● The accuracy and control of this gun is greatly improved by the Cutts Compensator. This ingenious attachment virtually nullifies the familiar tendency of all automatic weapons to climb or jump and at the same time greatly reduces the recoil. Even in full automatic fire the Thompson groups its shots within surprisingly narrow limits.

ON THE SIDE OF LAW AND ORDER

The simple, dependable control mechanism assures remarkable freedom from jams, misfires and breakage. Exhaustive tests by government experts have led to the official approval of the Thompson Gun for use in the U. S. Army, Navy, Marine Corps and the Coast Guard.

● This modern arm permits both semi-automatic or single-shot fire, and full automatic fire. When used semi-automatically, one hundred aimed shots per minute can be fired by separate trigger pulls. By a slight shift of the control lever, the weapon becomes a full automatic machine gun firing at a rate up to eight hundred shots per minute. Full automatic fire can be carefully regulated by the trigger pull so that "bursts" of two to six shots each are delivered. The positive control features of the Thompson permit it to be used from almost any firing position and from automobile, motorcycle, or any other vehicle.

● Model 28 AC—Official model of U. S. Naval and Military organizations.

● Firing rate, including time required for changing magazines, 300 shots per minute full automatically. Also will fire 100 aimed shots per minute when used semi-automatically. Cyclic rate of fire, 600 shots per minute.
